

"Actions are underway to deal with the demand but we would urge the public to work with us on this. If your call is less urgent then you will wait longer for help or be asked to make an alternative arrangement, including making your own way to hospital if necessary.

"We're hopeful that the actions we have put in place will start to take effect but until then, help us help you and only call if it's a genuine emergency."




